Encourages the use of natural supports; supports individuals to learn and enhance activities of daily living; and fosters involvement in social (family activities included), and community activities while maintaining safety of the individual. Provides hands-on assistance and instruction with activities of daily living and personal care as required by the individual supported. Assistance with making community and peer connections. The overall goal of supports is to maintain increased independence within an individual's home and community environment driven by person centered goals and planning. Performs other duties as assigned.
