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MENTAL HEALTH WAIVER PROGRAM-WISE

Ensures that services and interventions are highly individualized and tailored to the needs and preferences of the individual. Performs other duties as assigned. **EOE**

Job Requirements: Bachelor's degree required with a minimum of two (2) years' experience working in related behavioral health field. Certified Drug and Alcohol Counselor – CADAC or Certified Psychiatric Rehabilitation Practitioner – PRA certifications considered if working regularly scheduled hours in the Mental Health Waiver Program for a minimum of three (3) years. Prior experience working with people with persistent chronic mental illness and/or addiction. Valid Connecticut Driver's license is required. Scattered site and non-24 hr. program positions require the employee to maintain reliable transportation and be willing to transport clients in personal vehicles. Knowledge of the community support system and resources preferred. First Aid/CPR certification or willingness to obtain certification within 90 days of hire. Employee is responsible to maintain ongoing certification. Proficient computer skills required, including Microsoft Office and electronic record keeping.
